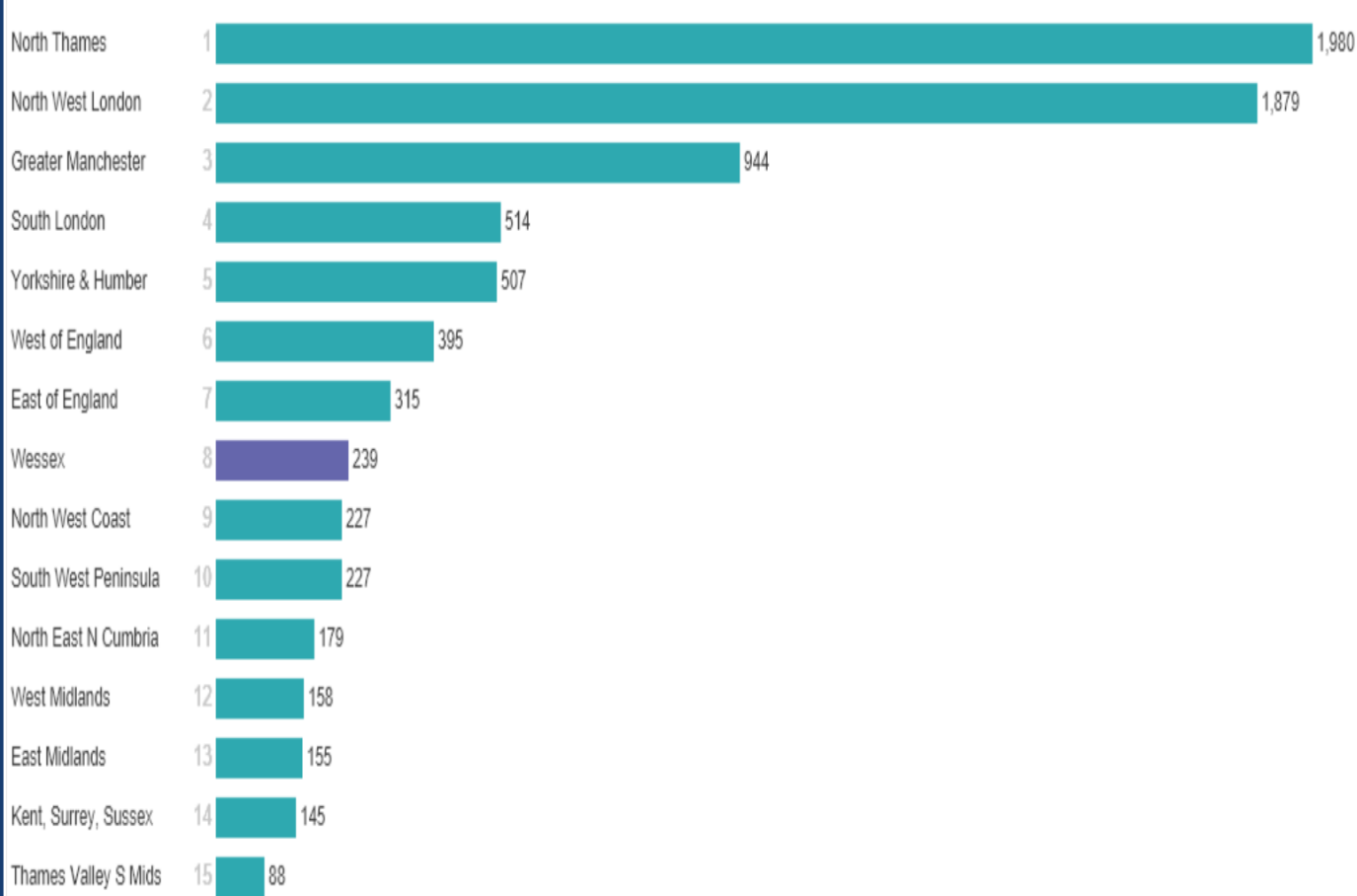
TRIALS UPDATE

- New Car T cell trials (3 in set up)
- TILs (Tumour infiltrating lymphocytes)
2 TILs trials currently open for lung and melanoma
- Expanding ATIMP portfolio
- **Maestro** – molecular profiling for patients with mCRPC
- **IDx Lung** - LUNG HEALTH CHECKS IN WESSEX AND YORKSHIRE: INTEGRATED BIOMARKER STUDIES

RECRUITMENT UPDATE

SO FAR IN 22/23 1310 PATIENTS HAVE BEEN RECRUITED TO 108 TRIALS ACROSS WESSEX WHICH PLACES US 8/15 NETWORKS FOR RECRUITMENT PER MILLION POP, SEE BELOW. LAST YEAR WE WERE 7TH.
