-  Nurse led cross organisational multidisciplinary working group to develop pathways for the implementation of paediatric whole genome sequencing
-  Genomics Tumour Advisory Board (GTAB) coordinator (a GTAB is a panel of clinical experts to provide advice regarding the analysis of patients' tumour/ germline genomic data to inform clinical care)
