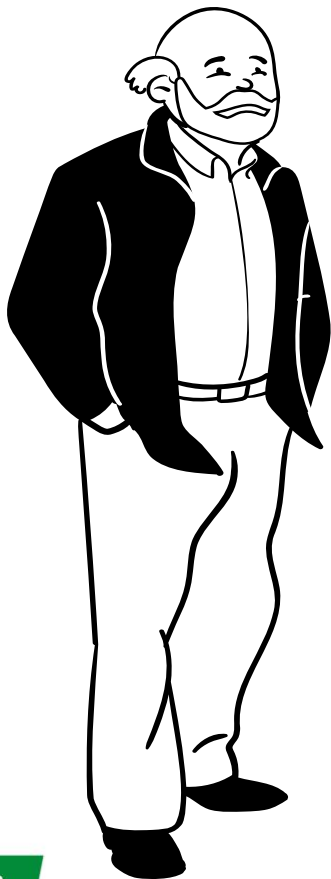

Case study

- Meet Joe, a Dorset man
- He is 61 years old and has been diagnosed with colorectal cancer.
- He works as a self-employed mechanic but can't work due to his back pain
- He lives with his wife and he has 3 children with the youngest still at home , age 17
- He had an operation to remove his cancer 3 years ago and has been under close surveillance since this time.
- The cancer has recently spread to his liver and bones and he had some emergency radiotherapy to his spine last month
- He has been offered chemotherapy to help control the cancer (palliative)
- He is struggling to pay his mortgage and feels increasingly anxious and low in mood

When and how do Macmillan professionals help Joe?

- At diagnosis
- During cancer treatment
- After cancer treatment
- When his cancer comes back
- When he feels low in mood
- When he struggles with money worries
- When he struggles with work
- When his family need help
- Towards the end of his life



Macmillan GPs and Macmillan Clinical Leads

- At all key points in the pathway from diagnosis, treatment, living with and beyond cancer and end of life care
- Macmillan Clinical Leads are in roles nationally. In Dorset we have Abi Orchard covering Dorset and the whole South West of England.
- At diagnosis can refer to Macmillan Support Line and website for personalised, trusted information via email or post
