What do we know?

CRUK report shows death rates 60% higher for people living in the most deprived areas compared with the least deprived

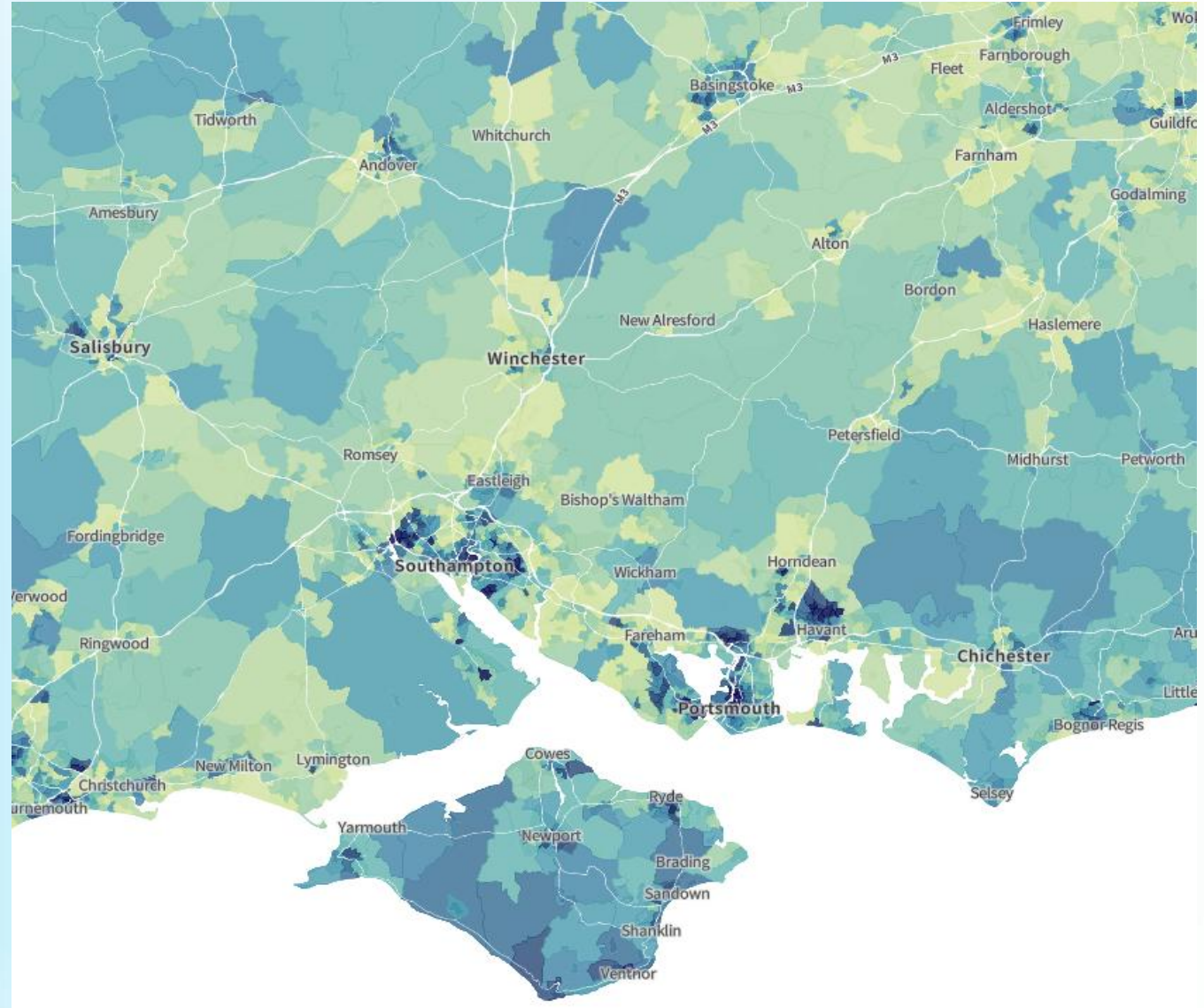
There is a relationship between deprivation and later diagnosis in HIOW and Dorset

Late diagnosis rate for people with LD (Dorset only) is 63% compared to 41% of the whole population

Examining data for breast cancer, Black women more likely to be diagnosed later in Wessex

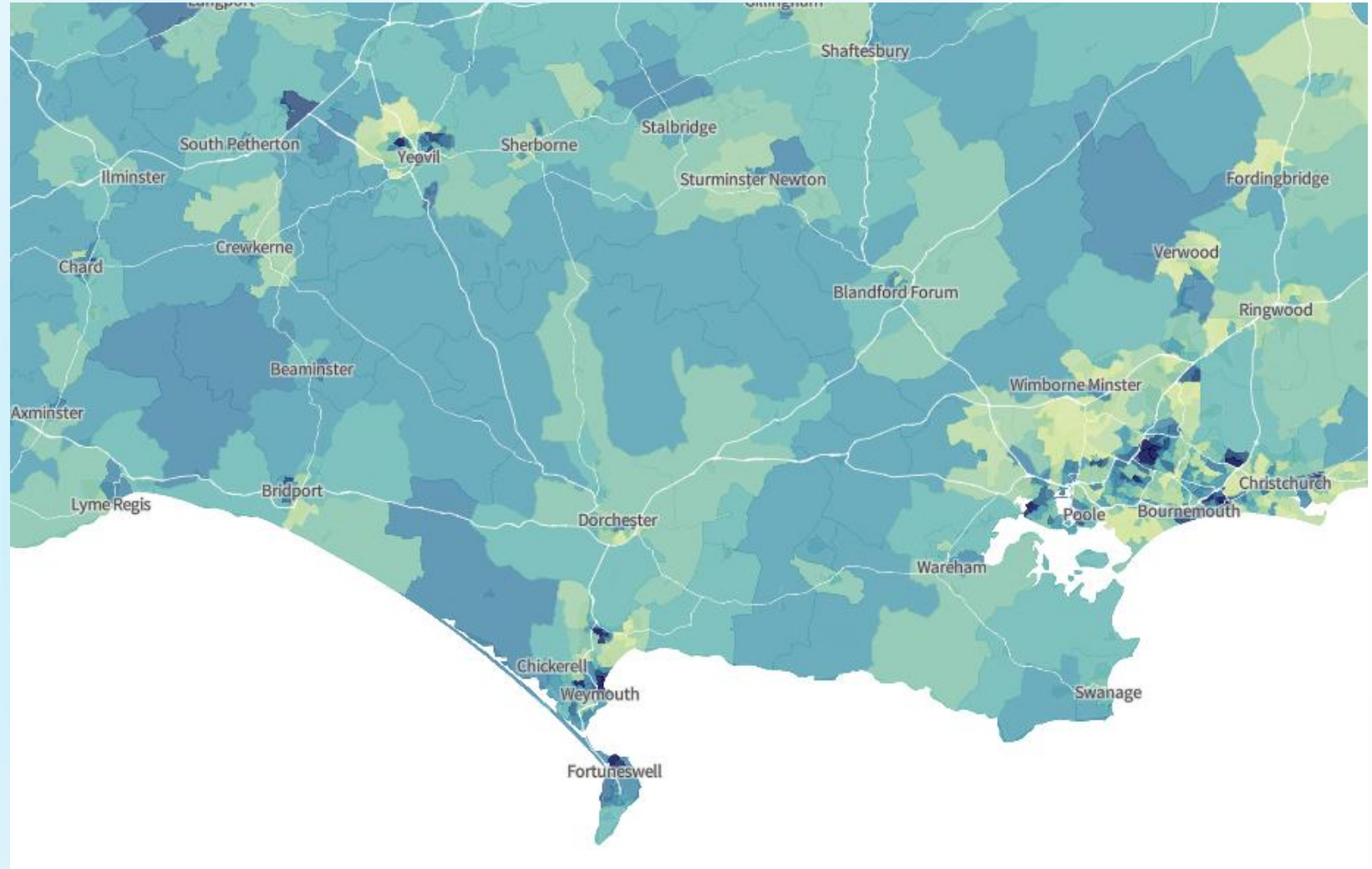


IMD in HIOW

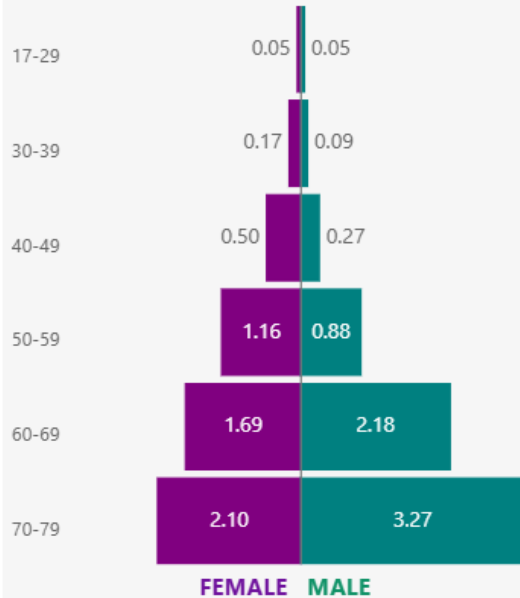

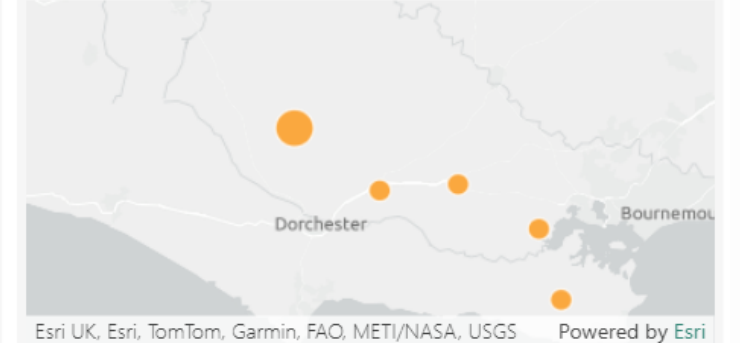

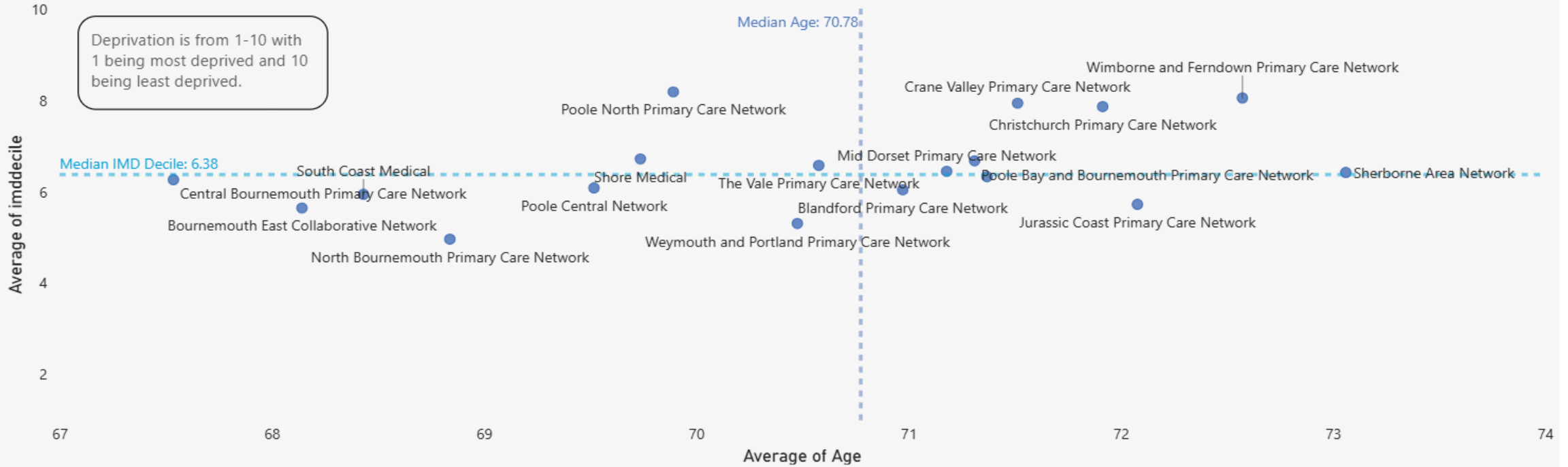

Why the gap?

- Preventable risk factors
- Later diagnosis
- Lower screening uptake
- More likely (nationally) to wait longer for care



Differences in experience of care

- NCPES imperfect tool but reveals key statistically significant differences for some groups
- Sensory loss
- Multiple long term conditions
- Age (both younger and older patients)
- Gender
